

Floyd County Farm Bureau Scholarship. Selection Criteria

Candidate must be a graduating high school senior from Floyd County.

Candidate must be accepted into Institute of Higher Learning and must be seeking to complete a course of study related to agriculture. A copy of the letter or other notice which indicate acceptance to Institute of Higher Learning must be attached to the scholarship application. The scholarship will be forwarded to Institute of Higher Learning to be credited to the recipient's first tuition bill.

Selection will be based upon the following weighted criteria:

1. An essay on the candidate's interest in agriculture and career plans in an agriculture related field – 40%
2. Academic achievement – 20%
3. Extracurricular activities and work experience – 20%
4. Agriculture or agriculture-related organization experience – 20%

The scholarship application must be submitted to the Floyd County Farm Bureau Scholarship Corporation by March 15th each year. The selected recipient will be notified on or about April 15th of each year.
