

Scholarship Application Form Quilters of Floyd

The Quilters of Floyd, established in 1977, is comprised of volunteers from New River Community Action, Inc. (NRCA) Retired and Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) and other community members. The mission of the Community Friendship Workshop is to develop a cottage industry with volunteers that will provide assistance where needed in the community through the sale of arts and crafts.

This scholarship award of \$200 is available to a graduating senior of Floyd County High School. Qualifications for this award are in line with the mission of the Quilters of Floyd. Please call the RSVP office at 745-2105 with questions about the requirements.

1. The applicant for this award will present a background of strong community service and volunteerism. Examples of work in this area include volunteer work of all kinds:
 - assisting the elderly for no pay
 - assisting charitable causes in the community through church youth group
 - volunteering for non-profits such as New River Community Action Food Pantry, RSVP, Floyd Head Start and American Cancer Society Relay for Life, for example
 - volunteering in groups to assist and strengthen the Floyd community such as Emergency Services Fire Departments and Rescue Squads
 - serving as a peer counselor in schools

Volunteering to help ones own family including grandparents does NOT count.

2. The applicant will present a history of a good work ethic.
3. The applicant will present evidence that he/she is college, vocational or trade school bound.

Along with this application, please submit:

1. A written essay (maximum 200 words or about three paragraphs) describing the applicant's feelings about community service and volunteerism.
2. Please make sure that the following points are covered in the essay: listing of the applicant's history of community service including (Who, What, When):
 - a. Who was served? Names of organizations, church mission or groups served; and the charitable purpose
 - b. What was done? Specific service activities that were done
 - c. When was it done? Dates of when the service was done
3. Two letters of reference: one from a teacher and one from a community member such as an employer, minister or neighbor.
