The Floyd County School Board has completed its search for a new superintendent and is pleased to announce the appointment of Dr. Jessica A. Cromer, who will officially begin her position as Division Superintendent of Schools on July 1, 2023.

Dr. Cromer has been serving Floyd County Public Schools since August of 2005. She began her career teaching middle school social studies and science at Check Elementary before moving into school administration as the Assistant Principal/CTE Director at Floyd County High School. Dr. Cromer returned to Check Elementary in 2013 as principal and has served as the Assistant Superintendent of Instruction and Innovation in Floyd County Public Schools since 2017.

Educationally, Dr. Cromer received a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Political Science from Virginia Tech in 2003 and a Master's Degree in Curriculum and Instruction from Virginia Tech in 2005. She also earned a Master's Degree in Educational Leadership from Radford University in 2009. Dr. Cromer completed her Doctorate Degree in Education at Radford University in 2022.

Dr. Cromer lives in Floyd County with her husband, Grady Cromer and their son, Bennett who will enter kindergarten at Check Elementary School this fall. They enjoy spending time outdoors and working on their cattle farm. The Cromer family is humbled and honored to be presented with this opportunity.
