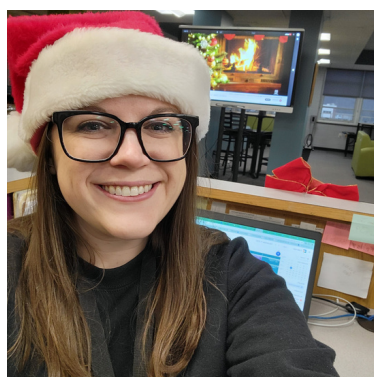

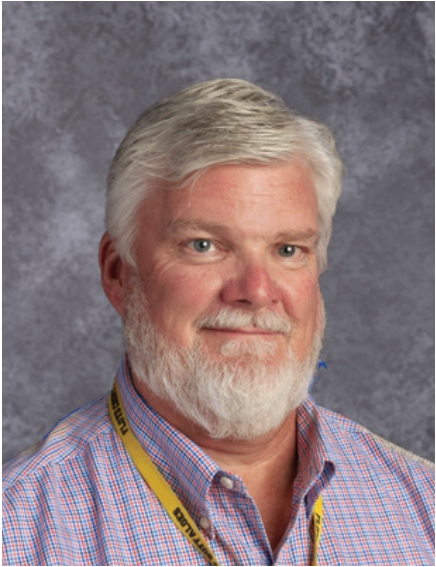

# FCHS Spreads Holiday Cheer

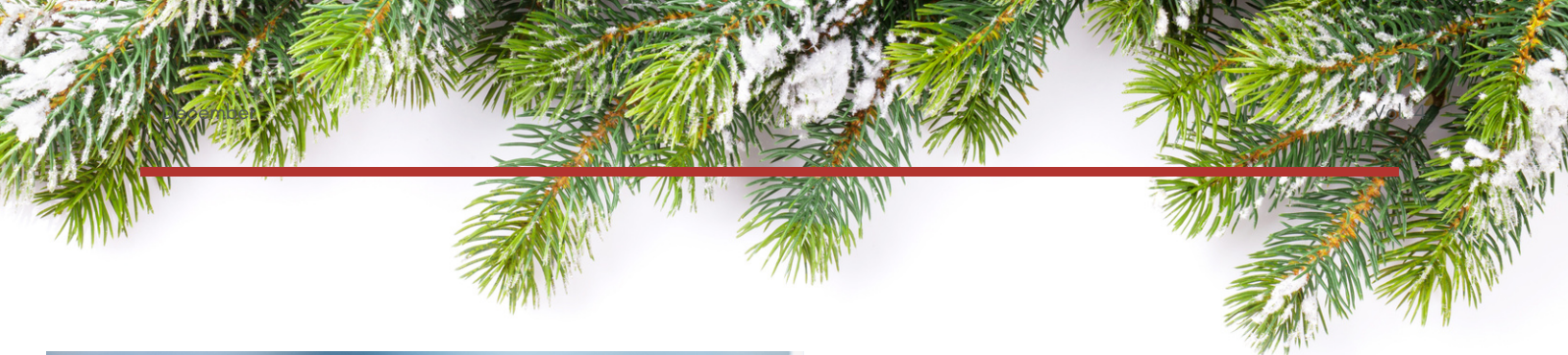
