Hello Floyd Families,

Our priority has been and continues to be maintaining our food and resource delivery to our families. At the same time, we want to do all we can to minimize social contact in public places.

We will be observing our spring break on Friday, April 10 and Monday, April 13. Meal deliveries will not occur on those days, but we will be including two sets of meals on Wednesday, April 8 and Thursday, April 9 to accommodate for the break.

Beginning the week of April 20, we will be changing our food delivery schedule to Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday. Students will receive two sets of meals on Monday and Thursday and one set of meals on Wednesday. Drive through services will also be on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays from 10 am to 12 pm.

Also, we have been notified of an additional waiver for emergency food service that allows the parent/guardian to pick up meals without children being present. We will ask for the name of the adult picking up the meal and the name of the child and the school they attend.
