

FCPS Families,

We are excited to provide an opportunity for students in grades 3-12 to improve their final grades. Please see the options below regarding grades for the remainder of this school year.

For yearlong courses, a 33.3% calculation for each marking period. An average of Q1, Q2, and Q3 will then be used for the final course grade. For semester-long, Semester 2 courses, the final grade will be calculated based on grades earned through March 13.

Grades will not be entered for Q4 on PowerSchool. To close out students' 2019-20 grades, two options are available for students in grades 3-12:

**Option I**

- Parent or guardian accepts final grade based on grades posted on Friday, April 2. (From work completed before March 13).
- Students and parents continue to work on materials provided by the teachers to reinforce skills and prepare for the 2020-21 school year and beyond.

**Option II**

- Students can improve their final grade by completing assignments shared by teachers. These opportunities will be provided by teachers beginning April 13. Students must complete and submit all assignments as assigned by their teachers, by Friday, May 22, at 4 p.m.
- Participation in the grade improvement plan can only improve a student's grade. Student grades will not decrease based on work completed as part of the optional recovery plan. \*

Student completes 80-100% of assignments to expectations.	10 points added to final grade
Student completes 70-80% of assignments to expectations.	8-9 points added to final grade
Student completes 50-70% of assignments to expectations.	6-7 points added to final grade
Student completes 25-50% of assignments to expectations.	4-5 points added to final grade
Student completes 1-25% of assignments to expectations.	2-3 points added to final grade

*\*Students will not exceed 100% for a final grade.*
