

## **Floyd County Public Schools - Summer/ESY SPED Services 2020**

Academic services will be delivered virtually.

For the following therapies: speech, occupational therapy, and physical therapy, parents will have a choice of coming in person or receiving services through teletherapy. All therapy sessions will be individual. There will be no group therapy sessions.

### **Screening Tool:**

### **Physical Therapy & Occupational Therapy:**

- PT and OT will be provided in person on an individual basis for the families who want this option (they may also choose to use teletherapy).
- Therapists will wear masks during therapy as some therapy requires personal contact.
- Students will be scheduled individually with time between sessions for cleaning of all surfaces.

- All equipment, door knobs, and other items that have been touched will be wiped down between sessions.
- Students will receive their therapy in two adjoining rooms (one room for PT and one for OT).
- Students will enter the back door of the building that is closest to the PT/OT rooms to avoid walking through the building.
- If students also receive speech, then they will walk through the main hallway to the front door to go out to the annex. No one will be allowed to walk through other areas of the building.
- There is a restroom in the therapy room that students may use and it will be cleaned between uses.

#### Speech Therapy:

- Speech therapy will be provided in person on an individual basis for the families who want this option (they may also choose to use teletherapy).
- Therapy will take place in the speech therapist's office in the FES Annex which has a separate entrance from the main building. If students also receive PT or OT, then they will walk through the main hallway to the therapy room. No one will be allowed to walk through other areas of the building.
- The therapist will wear a mask with a clear plastic piece over the mouth, or she will use a clear plastic shield or plexiglass between her and students. This is to allow students to watch her mouth as she demonstrates oral movements for speech sound production.
- Students will be scheduled individually with time scheduled for cleaning between students, or students will be scheduled to alternate in-person and virtual sessions to allow time for cleaning between in-person sessions.
- The annex has a bathroom and it will be cleaned and disinfected after every use.
- All equipment, door knobs, and other items that have been touched will be wiped down between students.
- Since therapy sessions will be individual, limited furniture and items will be used and cleaned and sanitized between sessions.

#### Basic Cleaning Plan for All Areas Used for Therapy:

- Daily complete cleaning of all surfaces
- Sanitizing all surfaces between students in areas students use to include: chairs, tables, tools, toys and any other items used during therapy.
